

Through our various programs, you can receive:



Our PROGRAMS



*MEDICAL ASSISTANT - ROP

Provides entry-level skills for people interested in a career as a medical assistant in a doctor's office, medical clinic or health service agency. Students participate in clinical training in a medical facility.

Q: Would you like helping people in a medical setting?

A: Consider one of our medical or dental programs!



*CERTIFIED VETERINARY ASSISTANT - ROP

Provides entry-level skills for people interested in a career as a veterinary assistant. Students participate in clinical training in veterinary facilities.

Q: Do you like the idea of building things out of metal?

A: Consider training in our Welding Academy!



*REGISTERED DENTAL ASSISTANT - ROP

Prepares students to carry out the duties of a Registered Dental Assistant. Students participate in clinical training in dental offices.

PHLEBOTOMY TECHNICIAN - ROP

This program prepares students to draw blood specimens from patients. Students participate in clinical training in labs.

PROFESSIONAL WELDING ACADEMY

This six-week academy provides participants the opportunity to learn basic skills while preparing for welding-related employment.
