

Our PROGRAMS



*MEDICAL ASSISTANT

Provides students with the necessary knowledge, skills and experience for entry-level employment as a medical assistant in a doctor's office, medical clinic or health service agency.



*CERTIFIED VETERINARY ASSISTANT

Provides entry-level skills for people interested in a career as a veterinary assistant. Students participate in clinical training in veterinary facilities.



*REGISTERED DENTAL ASSISTANT

Prepares students to carry out the duties of a Registered Dental Assistant. Students participate in clinical training which includes internships in dental offices.



PHLEBOTOMY TECHNICIAN

This program prepares students to draw blood specimens from patients. Students participate in clinical training in labs.



PROFESSIONAL WELDING ACADEMY

This six-week academy provides participants the opportunity to learn basic skills while preparing for welding-related employment.
